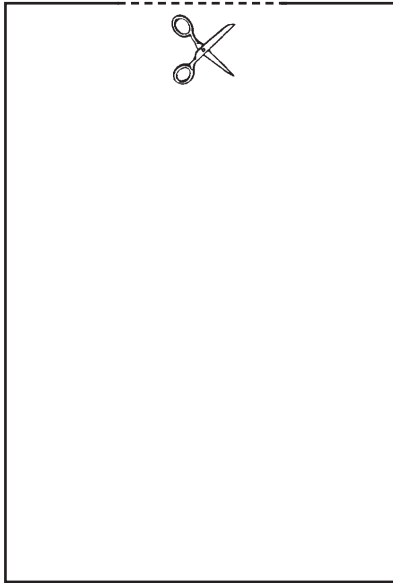


HOMEMADE PETER PAN COSTUME: THE TUNIC

materials needed: 1 ½ yards of green, crushed velvet fabric (more or less for your child's height, buy enough so that doubled it will hit mid-thigh) or a forest green pillow case, 1 leather shoelace, old brown leather belt or wide brown ribbon, scissors, needle, green thread, green tights, green long-sleeved t-shirt, brown boots

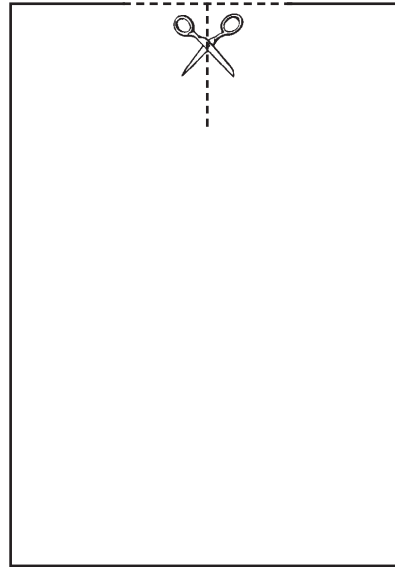
STEP 1

With fabric folded in half, or a green pillowcase, make a horizontal cut big enough for your child's head to fit through.



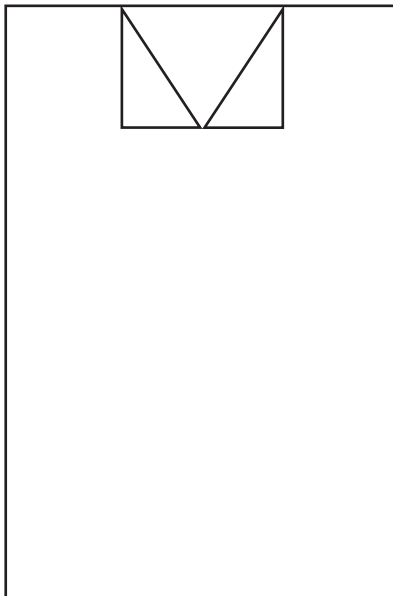
STEP 2

Only in front, make a vertical cut of about 4 inches.



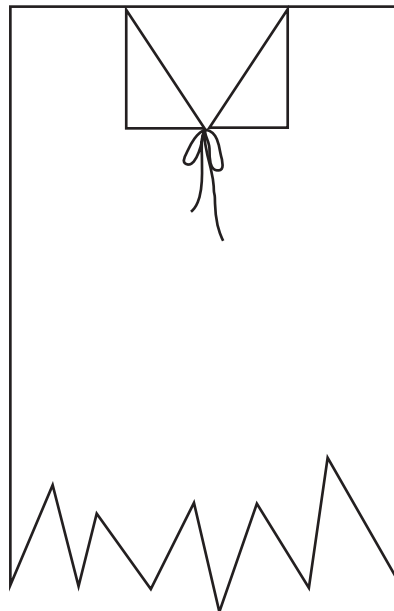
STEP 3

Fold each side back to form a V neckline and a collar. Lightly stitch collar down or use fabric glue to secure.



STEP 4

Cut bottom of fabric to create a jagged bottom edge. Stitch to secure leather shoe lace to bottom of V and tie.



FINISH by dressing your child in the green t-shirt, tights, and boots. Top with the tunic then belt it. Add the hat and you're off to Neverland!
